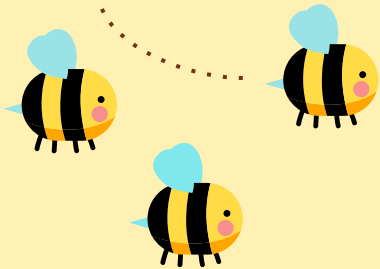

Curriculum



The American Early Childhood Education Program is designed for children 2 to 5 years of age. ECE is a unique preschool program based on child-centered, play-based learning and principles of individual personalities and community. Social and emotional learning is always at the heart of our Early Childhood Curriculum. And like all curricula, we find the most meaningful way to learn social skills is from each other! Teachers facilitate discussions with the whole class capturing child-led ideas and incorporating age-appropriate standards. Themed books and role-playing are often used to work out questions and issues that arise in the classroom.

Our program is centered around passion-based projects. Early Childhood students have opportunities to explore, hypothesize, question, and discuss their passions and interests while teachers facilitate, observe and document their discoveries. Teacher's observations, combined with student input, create the basis for our unique approach to curriculum, which we call Passion-Based Learning. It is the children's ideas and passions that guide individual and classroom projects. Our goal is to discover and deeply understand each child, including what they love, and how they learn best.



Curriculum



In addition to passion projects, students are introduced to beginning literacy, math, and science concepts through large group lessons, hands-on learning, and station work, all of which are documented in their Blueprint. Students have weekly Specialist courses including Performing Arts, Visual Arts, Gardening, Seed-To-Table, Foreign Language, and Outdoor Education.

The Early Childhood students are introduced to beginning literacy, math, and science concepts — all in a warm, nurturing environment. Students have weekly enrichment courses including Art, Performing arts Music, Gardening, Seed To Table, and Outdoor Education.

Children Are Shown Respect



Respect is the foundation of our teaching approach. Teachers instill respect and kindness in children by showing it to each child.

Kids Have Absorbent Minds



The young mind is ready and eager to learn. Children learn from their environments, and they are always absorbing new information. Hence creating an enriching learning experience.

Sensitive Periods Are Critical For Learning



We at Buzy Beez Preschool believe children can more easily learn certain information during sensitive periods of heightened learning. Teachers watch for these sensitive periods to make sure children are provided resources and opportunities for optimal learning.



Curriculum Goals For Children



Kids Learn Best In A Prepared Environment



This method believes that children learn best in an environment equipped with resources and opportunities to actively learn and freely explore. A prepared environment gives children the independence to choose their own learning and try things for themselves. Teachers can prepare the best environment for children by observing children. Make sure a variety of materials are provided. Organizing resources so children can easily find them.

Kids Can Teach Themselves Through Auto Education



Auto education means that children are able to teach themselves through active exploration. Teachers can encourage children to learn and explore by introducing them to new materials in the prepared environment.

Our classrooms are inspired by the lifecycle of a bee. For the appropriate age group enrollment, your child's age will be considered in August of the current academic year. Please note that a child starts Grade 1 at the age of 6 years as per the American Standards and Year 1 at the age of 5 as per British Standards.

In KSA, after completion of all three steps at BUZY BEEZ PRESCHOOL, your child will enroll in KG3 or Year 1.



Larva- Age 2-3 Years Old



- Our playgroup program enables your child to interact socially with children other than their families and daily caregiver.
- They learn about sharing and getting along with others while having fun! The children are exposed to a variety of art media such as paint, glue, crayons, magnets, and play dough.
- The children also enjoy snack time together, listening to stories and singing. This experience allows the opportunity to ease into the Pupa classroom setting.



Pupa- Age 3-4 Years Old

- A “personal choice time” which fosters independence by allowing each child to choose their own activities while the teachers provide guidance.
- “Circle time” promotes structure and routine. The children learn to listen, speak to a group and sit still while enjoying a variety of songs and stories pertinent to the day’s discussion.
- Both gross and fine motor skills are exercised through a variety of play and class activities.
- The teachers also focus largely on the child using their “words” to communicate their wants and needs, which helps kids to share and interact with one another better.
- Personal hygiene and health-related issues are emphasized, such as hand-washing and sneezing etiquette.
- Shapes and colors are a large part of our curriculum as well as letters and numbers, in preparation for our Pre-K program.

Adult- Age 4-5 Years Old

- Our Pre-K Programs offer many first-time educational experiences.
- The daily routine provides structure, guidance, and independence.
- Each class offers small group centers where math, science, art, letter & number recognition, and motor skills are introduced and mastered.
- The complete alphabet is introduced, using both upper and lower case letters.
- Circle time is where the calendar, jobs, and group discussions take place.
- As class comes to an end the students gather for a snack and a song.
- The teacher provides two progress reports throughout the year to ensure your child is developing all of the necessary skills needed for kindergarten.
- It is our personal goal to make Pre-K a fun and educational first school experience.
- Our students participate in many out-of-the-classroom field trips through town.

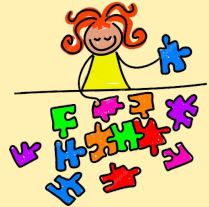

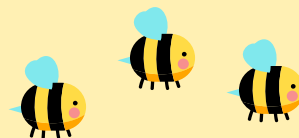
